It's a posh Manhattan import through and through, with cozy leather couches, black mirrored ceilings, a VIP area and thinly clad waitresses. The scene at Whiskey Park is a diverse crowd, with young urban professionals mixing with Europeans decked in clubbing garb. There's never a cover, but as you can expect, it's not cheap once you get inside. Patrons can order food from the Park Plaza Hotel's kitchen anywhere in the club, and most drinks start at \$10.

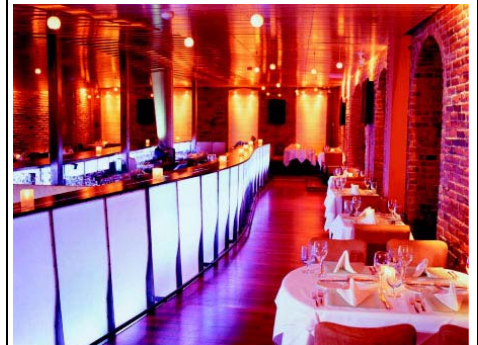
The Restaurant
