



ACYOA Summer Mission Trip
Diocese of the Armenian Church of America (Eastern)
FACT SHEET

WHAT IS THE ACYOA SUMMER MISSION TRIP?: This is a weekend-long, faith-based service trip for young adults to provide outreach to a mission parish of the Eastern Diocese and its community at large. Programs similar to this have been done in the past, but have been dormant in recent years. The ACYOA is excited to revive this initiative by partnering with Habitat for Humanity as they build a home near the St. Garabed Armenian Church in Kansas City, MO.

WHO CAN SIGN UP?: This trip is open to all young adults ages 16 to 25 from parishes across the Eastern Diocese who are physically capable of participating on a Habitat for Humanity worksite and are interested in providing service and outreach to the local parish community. This trip will be limited to 18 participants, plus a clergyman leader and two assistant trip leaders. All applications will be thoughtfully reviewed, and acceptance will be determined based on an applicant’s essay questions and ability to fully contribute to the mission and purpose of the trip. Priority will be given to first-time participants.

WHAT’S COVERED & WHAT’S NOT?: This program costs approximately \$15,000. The cost of the program is being underwritten by the ACYOA, using grant monies received by the Dadourian Foundation. All participants will be provided lodging (3-4 people to a room, sharing two queen beds), ground transportation by van, and three meals a day. In addition, the participant fees and donation of \$2,000 for Habitat for Humanity will be paid for by the ACYOA. Please bring spending money to cover any incidentals you may have while traveling.

TRAVEL INFORMATION: Participants will need to coordinate and pay for their own transportation to/from the Kansas City International Airport (MCI). Participants should arrive as early as 6:00 PM, but no later than 9:00 PM on Thursday, June 11, and depart no earlier than 5:00 PM on Sunday, June 14. Please consult with the DYYAM before booking flights outside these recommendations. All participants will be expected to complete an online travel survey by May 31 with their arrival and departure information, so that airport pick-ups and drop-offs can be coordinated and communicated in advance. Please wait to make travel arrangements until you have received an acceptance and confirmation email.

WHAT TO PACK: Clothing: For the Worksite: work clothes such as jeans, long-sleeve shirts, sweatshirts, etc, work gloves, work boots, coat, hat, scarf, etc. Check the weather and dress in layers as

the morning may be chilly and the afternoon warm. No open-toed shoes will be allowed on the worksite. For the evenings: On Friday night, we will be visiting parishioners' homes, and on Saturday night, we will be spending time at the parish. Please wear nicer clothes for both of these evenings, such as “business casual” or “snappy casual” (e.g., nice pants with a dressy shirt or sweater). Please do not wear blue jeans, t-shirts, or sweatshirts for the evening gatherings. For Sunday morning: proper attire for church. Additional: pajamas, shoes, socks, underwear, etc. **Toiletries:** soap, shampoo/conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, razor, tissues, feminine hygiene products, band-aids, baby wipes, medications, hand sanitizer, etc. **Miscellaneous:** Bible, notebook and pen (to keep a daily journal), sunglasses, camera, reusable water bottle and/or coffee mug, etc.

MEDICAL: Please consult with your physician to ensure that you are physically capable of participating in the Habitat for Humanity worksite, which will include manual labor. We encourage you to make sure you are up-to-date on all immunizations, including your tetanus shot (or booster). Please consider getting one if you have not had one in the last ten years. If you are taking medication, be sure to bring an adequate supply. You should also bring any over-the-counter medication that you may need (cold pills, anti-diarrhea medicine, aspirin, decongestants, etc.). If you wear glasses or contact lenses and cannot see without them, we suggest you bring a spare pair just in case. Should you have any medical concerns during your trip, please inform the leader immediately, and he will consult with the closest medical facility to get you the care you need.

IN AND AROUND MCI: Participants will be flying in/out of MCI Airport. Hotel information will be announced shortly. You will be picked up by mini-vans and driven to the hotel. On Friday and Saturday mornings, we will drive by van to the HFH worksite in the Lykins neighborhood of Kansas City. On Saturday evening and Sunday morning, we will serve at the St. Garabed Armenian Church.

VISITING FAMILY & FRIENDS IN KANSAS CITY: Our schedule will be jam-packed and will not provide free time away from the group. Therefore, we ask that you do not make plans with local family and friends during this trip. You are welcome to arrive early or stay longer if you desire. In addition, no guests are permitted to visit your room or stay overnight with you at the hotel.
